By Plane

Frankfurt Rhein-Main International Airport is one of the largest airports in Europe and is served by all major domestic and international airlines.

From the Airport...

By Train

A train station for local trains (Regionalbahnhof) is located in Terminal 1 Take S8 with final destination Wiesbaden HBF to go to Mainz. Leave the train at Mainz HBF, the second stop after crossing the Rhine.

By Car

Route 50 leads to Autobahn 61, to Autobahn 60, with four exits leading directly into Mainz.

By Taxi

A taxi from Frankfurt airport to Mainz will cost around 50 Euros with a journey time of 30-40 minutes. From the various hotels in downtown Mainz, this will take around 15 minutes. The cost for a taxi is less than 20 Euros.
