By Plane

Frankfurt Rhein-Main International Airport (25 minutes)

- Fly into Frankfurt Rhein-Main International Airport. Frankfurt Airport is one of the largest airports in Europe and is served by all major domestic and international airlines
- A train station for local trains (Regionalbahnhof) is located in Terminal 1
- Take S8 with final destination Wiesbaden HBF to go to Mainz
- Leave the train at Mainz HBF (main train station), the second stop after crossing the Rhine

Frankfurt-Hahn

- Roughly an hour away from Mainz is Hahn Airport, a former US Airbase near Simmern. Some domestic carriers and other discounted airlines like Ryanair use Hahn as a hub for inexpensive, no-frills flights to under-utilized or secondary airports in the UK, Ireland, France, Italy, Spain, the Benelux countries, Scandinavia and eastern Europe.
- Scheduled buses run hourly to Mainz. Get off at Mainz HBF (main train station)

Then continue by taxi or tram and bus as indicated below

By Train

- Rail travel to Mainz is easy. More than 160 local, regional, national and international trains arrive daily at the main train station
- High-speed ICE and other express trains linking northern Germany with Switzerland, Italy and southern France stop at Mainz and trains from all parts of Germany and eastern Europe connect

Then continue by taxi or tram and bus as indicated below

By CAR:

From North or East, Frankfurt Airport, A60 (25 minutes from Airport)

- After crossing the Rhine River, take the third exit, Hechtsheim-West. The sign shows a small industrial zone logo
- At the third traffic light, turn left onto Robert-Bosch-Straße
- At the next crossing, turn right onto Adam-Opel Straße
- Take the next left onto Robert-Koch-Str. Gutenbergpark, Robert-Koch-Str. 50, Eingang A is 200m ahead on the right

From South or West, A60

- At motorway crossing Mainz-Süd, follow A60 towards Frankfurt
- Leave A60 at the Hechtsheim-West exit (the first exit after the Motorway Crossing). The sign shows a small industrial zone logo
- At the third traffic light, turn left onto Robert-Bosch-Straße
- At the next crossing, turn right onto Adam-Opel Straße
- Take the next left onto Robert-Koch-Str. Gutenbergpark, Robert-Koch-Str. 50, Eingang A is 200m ahead on the right

By Tram and Bus

(25 to 45 minutes depending on connection)

- From Hauptbahnhof / Schillerplatz take tram 50 / 51 to “Hechtsheim Bürgerhaus” (final destination as displayed on the train)
- Leave train at stop Mühl dreieck
- Switch to Bus 66 to “Nieder-Olm Bahnhof” (destination displayed on the bus)
- Leave bus at stop “Werners Backstube” on Robert-Bosch-Straße
- From the bus stop on Robert-Bosch-Straße, turn left into the unpaved pedestrian walkway and again right onto Robert-Koch-Straße
- Robert-Koch-Straße 50 is the tall building on the left
- CAE Healthcare is on 2nd floor of entrance A

Alternatively, you can walk from the tram stop “Mühl dreieck”

- Cross the street and enter into “Robert-Bosch-Straße”
- Turn left at the first intersection into “Robert-Koch-Straße”
- Follow the street for about 10 to 15 minutes until Robert-Koch-Str. 50 on your left

By TAXI

From the city centre (15 minutes)
